K5 PROGRESSIVE ENTRY

Dear parents and families,

We are hard at work preparing for the new school year at Riverview and we are looking forward to welcoming our new and returning **K5 students** to the school! I am pleased to be returning as Principal and I know that your child will be warmly welcomed by the staff when school begins. Thank you for trusting us with your child's education.

School begins for all students on Thursday, August 29th, 2024, but we have planned a progressive school entry for our 5 year old Kindergarten students to make their transition to school as smooth as possible. During the shortened days, please send your child in with a small bag containing only a water bottle and a change of clothes in case of any washroom accidents. On their first FULL day, Tuesday, September 3rd, class lists will be finalized* and all school supplies can be sent in. At that point, the SEED Daycare program and school bus services will also begin (for those registered).

*Please note that adjustment may be made in the classes until the end of the first week of school.

For the progressive school entry, K5 students will be divided as follows:

GROUP A: Students with last names beginning with the letters A-K

GROUP B: Students with last names beginning with the letters L-Z

Thursday, August 29th

GROUP A (A-K) attends from 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

GROUP B (L-Z) attends from 10:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Students will be welcomed and dismissed by the gym gate entrance on Godin.

Friday, August 30th

GROUP A (A-K) attends from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

GROUP B (L-Z) attends from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Students will be welcomed and dismissed by the gym gate entrance on Godin.
