MCGILL PSYCH-ED COUNSELING CLINIC:

For students who may have been referred for a psycho-educational evaluation, the McGill Psychoeducational and Counselling Clinic coordinator confirmed that they are still accepting a few referrals for their waitlist for assessments this year. They provide excellent assessments at a slightly reduced fee. They work on a sliding scale up to 1800\$. Once waitlisted clients are contacted for intake, they will be required to complete a Document for Fee Assessment Form and submit proof of total household income. The cost of service will be determined based on the client's financial situation. If a client is unwilling to complete the form and/or submit supporting documentation their fee will be set on the upper end of the scale. For more information, please see: [MCGILL CLINIC](#). GRADE 6 INFORMATION:

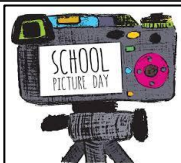
