DRESSING FOR THE WEATHER:

Last week we had a couple of indoor recesses, but our goal is to have students outside as much as possible. As a rule, temperatures with or without windchill lower than -20 will result in an indoor recess for part of the day... but wind and sun also contribute to the decision. **NOTE:** Teachers have been asked to remind students to dress warmly and wear all items sent in by parents. Students without snow pants are permitted to walk around with friends outside, close to the building, and/or sit on the picnic tables, but ARE NOT permitted to play in the snow to avoid being wet for the remainder of the day in the classroom. Please reinforce this message with students for their comfort.

SCHOOL AND SEED DAYCARE FEES:

In order to ensure the smooth running of programs, it is essential that all families do their best to catch up on any unpaid school and SEED/Daycare fees. The January invoices for lunch and after school activities will be out shortly and families who have accumulated debt over \$500 are asked to reach out to make a plan with Ms. Brown to ensure that SEED services can be maintained. Specific email reminders will be sent to those concerned. We are happy to work out payment plans wherever possible.
