LBPSB RECIPE BOOK:

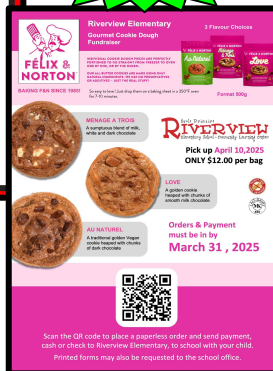
Happy Nutrition Month! 🥗🍓🍌
