We are hard at work preparing for the new school year at Riverview and we are looking forward to welcoming our new and returning **K5 students** and their families to the school! Here is a list of school supplies that your child will need for the beginning of the school year. Please make sure that <u>your child's name is on all</u> pieces of clothing, school bag & lunch bag, pencils, **INCLUDING EVERY MARKER**.

ESSENTIALS:

- 1 school bag large enough to bring home blanket, lunch box and binder
- 1 lunch box with a <u>reusable container for water</u>
- 1 beach towel or small blanket for rest time (must be labeled with the child's name and <u>must fit</u> into an <u>extra-large self-locking bag</u>)
- 1 plastic bag (large freezer self-locking bag), containing a full change of clothes (just in case of an accident)
- painting smock with <u>long sleeves (an oversized shirt will do)</u>
- <u>velcro</u> running shoes (shoes that light up are not recommended)

CLASSROOM SUPPLIES:

- 1 plastic box to store markers & glue stick (around 8" x 5")
- 3 boxes of <u>large</u> **washable** markers (not pastel colors), please keep markers in original box
- 1 box of 24 sharpened coloring pencils
- 1 rigid 3-ring binder, 1 inch capacity (HARD COVER PLEASE NOT FLEXIBLE)
- 1 eraser
- 3 large glue sticks (100 g) (<u>NOT</u> purple glue)
- 1 pair of round-tip children's scissors
- OPTIONAL:

2 packages of school appropriate stickers - NO English wording, please.
