WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE Annual General Assembly (AGA)

- The Governing Board Annual Report is presented.
- The parents elect parents to the Governing Board for 2-year terms.
- The parents elect parents to serve as substitute Governing Board members (the number of substitute parents should not exceed the total number of parent members).
- The parents elect, from amongst the Governing Board parents, a Parent Representative and an Alternate Parent Representative to the LBPSB Parents' Committee.
- The parents who are present will determine if the school will have a PPO for the year.

GOVERNING BOARD

What is a Governing Board?

Every public school in Quebec has a Governing Board (GB). They are responsible for issues involving school life, the annual budget and the development of school policies. They are also the primary consultative bodies for School Board policies.

In addition to parents, our GB consists of staff who are voting members, elected from and by their constituents. Two community representatives and the principal have a voice, but no vote. Monthly meetings will be held on dates chosen by the elected members and published on the website.

How Do I Join the Governing Board?

Complete & submit the Nomination form to the school office by September 4th at 3:00 p.m., **or by email to** <u>abrown@lbpsb.qc.ca</u>, **or** attend the AGA and present yourself in person by giving a 2-minute talk about yourself and the reasons for your candidacy.

Members of the Governing Board will be elected by secret ballot.

Parent Participation Organization

The PPO provides a forum for parents to share ideas. Its role is to promote the collaboration of parents in developing, implementing and evaluating the school's educational project. They may advise the parent members of the Governing Board or can be consulted by them on any matter. The number and schedule of meetings will be determined by the PPO.

Parents who attend the Annual General Assembly will decide whether to establish and declare a school-level Parent Participation Organization (PPO).
