### LOCKDOWN DRILL:

This Thursday, students and staff will participate in our annual lockdown drill. It is most important to emphasize that the point of the drill is to have students and staff remain calm, sitting quietly in a designated spot in their class to await any instructions. It is NOT presented as something scary, but, much like a fire drill, to be prepared to act quickly in case of any emergency. A lockdown ("Code Red") can be called for a variety of reasons and the point is to be safe, but NOT fearful. While serious, we do not want to instill panic. Please help us to reassure students by reviewing this with them. Thank you for your support!

### PAYMENT OF FEES:

Just a quick reminder to all parents about the possibility of paying school fees online. Please login to your parent Mozaik Portal to see monthly SEED invoices and keep all payments up to date to avoid interruptions in service later in the year. 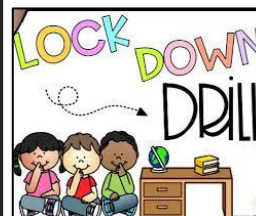
