IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- 1. Please note that school fee bills are being sent home and can be paid online. Be sure to use the proper payee as there are different accounts for school fees and SEED/Lunch fees. Alternatively, you can come to the office to pay by debit or cash. The deadline for payment is October 31st. Please make every effort to eliminate any outstanding debt or to speak with Ms. Brown if a payment plan is required.
- 2. The emergency and medical forms sent home in the brown envelope last week should be completed and returned as soon as possible for our system to be updated.
- 3. If your child has an epipen, asthma pumps, or other medication that must be left at school, please bring it to Ms. Kim (with the original prescription label) to ensure your child's safety in case of emergency.

FIRE DRILLS AND LOCKDOWNS:

Part of our safety protocol includes having a minimum of six fire drills and one lockdown drill over the course of the school year. As it was explained to students at the recent assemblies, these drills are not to instill fear, but to practice the calm, quick evacuation required in case of an emergency. A "CODE RED" lockdown can be called for a variety of reasons and simply means that staff and students must remain quiet and await instructions in their classrooms. The first fire drill was completed last Friday and went very well! The students were quiet, calm, and cooperative. Great job Champions!
